The Governing body of Andhra Loyola Institute of Engineering and Technology (ALIET) met on 20<sup>th</sup> November 2021, virtually, at 3:00 PM. The following are the minutes of the meeting.

The meeting started with a prayer by Fr P. Balashowri, S.J., Vice-president, Loyola College Society. Then the president of Loyola College Society, Fr K.S. Stanislaus, S.J., welcomed the gathering. In his welcome address, the president appreciated the efforts made by staff and management for getting NBA accreditation for the five programs of the institute.

Dr O. Mahesh, Principal of ALIET, presented the academic report. Dr M.H.M. Krishna Prasad appreciated the institute for getting NBA accreditation for five programs. He expressed his satisfaction on placements. To improve placements, he advised to have collaboration with industry and encourage students to go for internships. He expressed that staff should be encouraged to publish papers in SCOPUS indexed journals. He also advised to modify the mission statement of the institute. Mr G Rangaraju, Industrialist, expressed that the efforts should be made to get better fee structure. According to him, higher fee is essential to recruit highly qualified faculty members, provide good infrastructure and also to pay better salaries. He also observed that the demand for branches like Electrical and Electronics Engineering (EEE), Mechanical Engineering (ME) and Civil Engineering(CE) is decreasing year after year. In many colleges seats are not getting filled completely. On the other hand, in Computer Science and Engineering (CSE) related branches, demand is growing. He suggested, to reduce intake in branches, where the demand is getting reduced and go for enhancing intake or setting up new branches in which demand is expected to grow.

Mr T. Sekhar, Principal of Govt. Polytechnic college, expressed that due to pandemic situation, students were confined to online classes. Now they are attending offline classes. To ensure safety and security of faculty members and students, he suggested, initiating steps for 100 percent vaccination of students and staff members.



Fr Dr A. Francis Xavier, S.J., presented statement of income and expenditure of year 2020-21. It was approved by the Governing Body. He expressed that it is becoming highly challenging for the management, for timely payment of salaries due to inadvertent delay in the receipt of fee reimbursement dues from the State Government. Fr Dr A. Francis Xavier, S.J., expressed that we make efforts to increase intake for the academic year 2022-23. We will apply for two additional sections in CSE related branches.

Mr Ramakrishna of ECE department expressed through APSSDC laboratories, 6900 students from various colleges are trained as of now. Out of which, 1400 students belong to this college. Fr K.S. Stanislaus, S.J., in his concluding remarks, expressed satisfaction with the performance of the institute and emphasized the need for improving the results of EEE and ME branches.

Finally the meeting was concluded by Fr. N Britto Martin Paul, S.J., Asst. Director, with a vote of thanks.
