SENSITISATION PROGRAMME ON WORLD WATER DAY


Event: Conservation of Water

Event: Awareness on Ozone layer

This year's 2021 theme for the International Day for the Prevention of the Ozone Layer is 'Montreal Protocol Keeping food, us, our and vaccines cool.' The Ozone layer is a piece of the atmosphere that has high ozone concentrations. Ozone is a gas that is made of three oxygen atoms, O3. Depending on where the ozone layer is, it can either harm life or protect life on Earth. Most of the ozone stays within the stratosphere, whereby it acts as a shield, protecting the surface of the Earth from the harmful ultraviolet radiation of the sun. If this shield was to weaken, we would all be more susceptible to impaired immune systems, cataracts, and skin cancer. World Ozone Day is observed on September 16, every year.

It is celebrated to spread awareness among students of S.K.R.M.C.High School, Vijayawada, about the depletion of the Ozone Layer and search for possible solutions to preserve it. On this day, people from all over the world are expected to join the Montreal protocol to join the talks and seminars.
