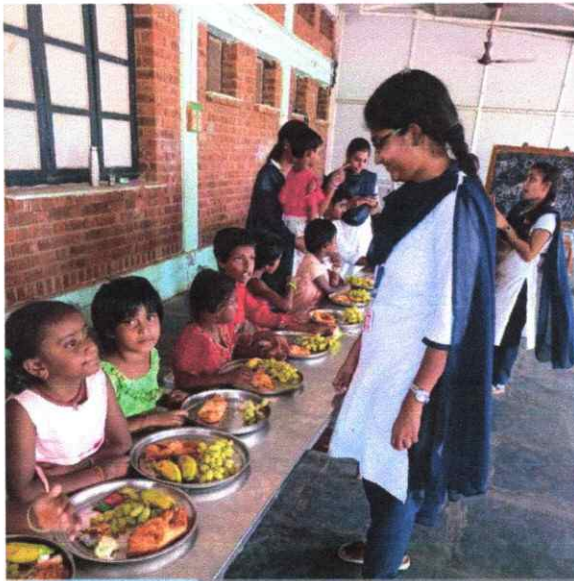

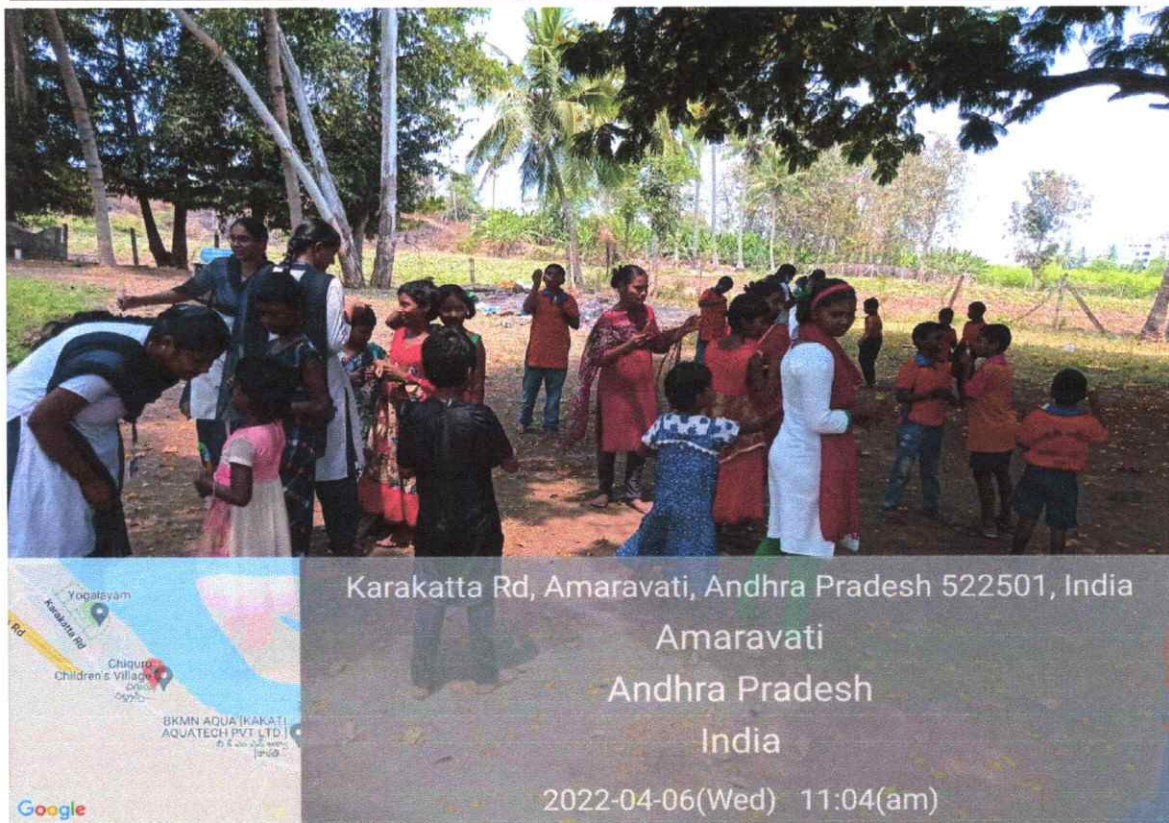




A Day with Myself – An Inter Religious Meet for Self Awareness and Self Reflection

Date: 13th & 14th November, 2021

30 Students of Andhra Loyola Institute of Engineering and Technology, Vijayawada went into forests of East Godavari Agency to spend two days with the Koya and Konda Reddy tribes as a part of extension activity. The group stayed at the hamlets of Katukapalle, Venkatapuram which are located along the interstate borders of Telangana and Chhattisgarh on 13th and 14th November and studied lifestyle of the tribals along with celebrations of children's day with the young ones of the tribes by conducting singing and dance competition, also distributed prizes to the children.

Students split up into teams and visited the huts at Katukapalle and Chimili Vaagu, which have a population of around 200 each. The Director of Andhra Loyola Institute of Engineering and Technology Fr.Dr.A.Francis Xavier also accompanied the students. Students observed that there were no medical, education, drinking water, electricity and road transport facilities to Katukapalle. Children of koya tribe are suffering from malnutrition and are underweight, lack of proper clothing and drinking water facilities.

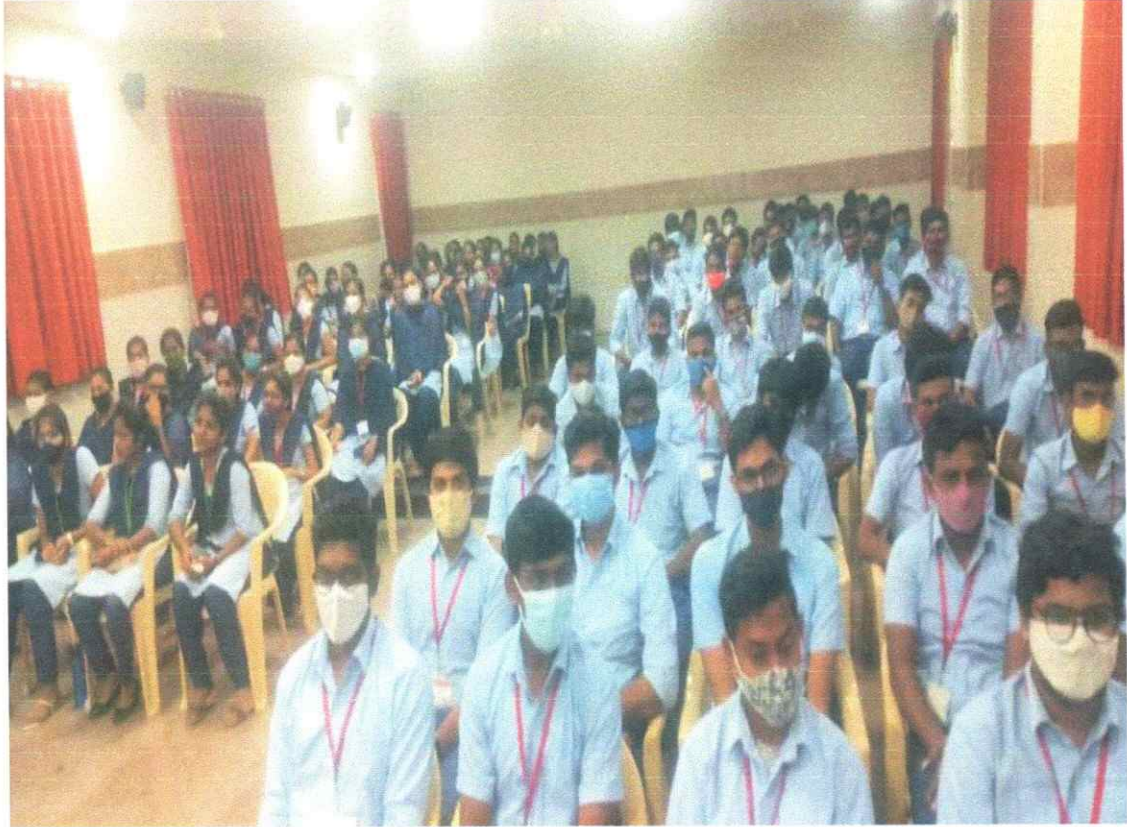

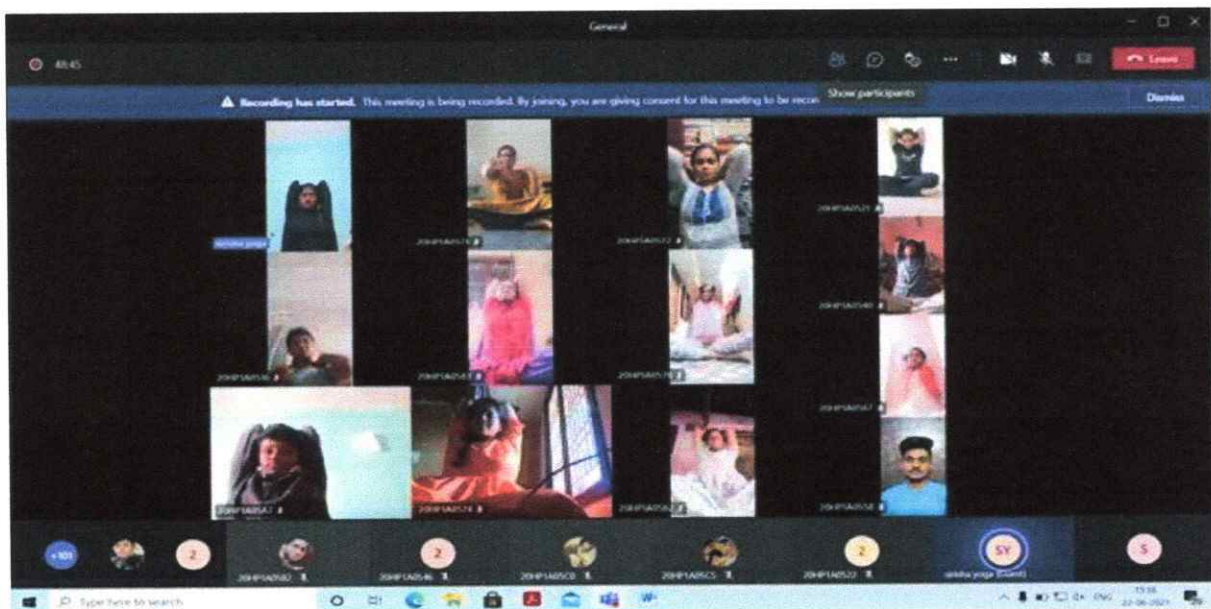


Yoga for Well-being

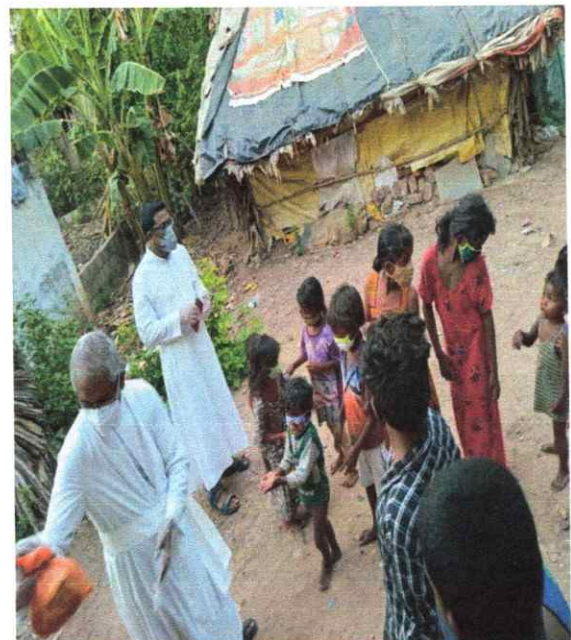
Event: Second Wave of Covid-19
