- **Organization wide awareness:**

- To create awareness among students regarding acts and punishments pertaining to ragging activities, posters in this regard are displayed at different locations in the college, and students are advised to read them carefully
- Number of banners / posters giving detailed descriptions of Anti-Ragging activities such as Supreme court directives and penalty liable to be imposed on those involved in such activities, are displayed in the corridors and at various places within the campus
- Students are oriented to build cordial relations among students for fulfilling organization's mission and Objectives.

- **Mechanism Involved :**

- Anti-Ragging squads are constituted comprising of faculty members to make surprise visits to very sensitive location within the campus namely, corridors, canteen, parking lot and out gate in the morning and in the break- time (11.50-12.45)
- The timings of the college for I B.Tech students are changed in order to avoid any kind of ragging on the campus.
- Anti- Ragging squads supervise the students after the college hours (4.30pm) at nearby bus stops to avoid ragging
- For an offence committed in the department or a classroom and elsewhere, the institution shall have the authority to reprimand fine or take any other suitable measure.
- Assault in any form, verbal, non-verbal or physical is strictly prohibited. Serious action will be taken against offenders.
- Anti-Ragging committee of the college is successful in maintaining the campus ragging-free since its inception.

Ragging

Prohibition of ragging in educational institutions Act 26 of 1997

Salient Features

- ⇒ Ragging within or outside any educational institution is prohibited.
- ⇒ Ragging means doing an act which causes or is likely to cause Insult or Annoyance of Fear or Apprehension or Threat or Intimidation or outrage of modesty or Injury to a student

Teasing, Embarrassing and Humiliation	 6 Months	+	Rs. 1,000/-
Assaulting or Using Criminal force or Criminal intimidation	 1 Year	+	Rs. 2,000/-
Wrongfully restraining or confining or causing hurt	 2 Years	+	Rs. 5,000/-
Causing grievous hurt, kidnapping or Abducts or rape or committing unnatural offence	 5 Years	+	Rs. 10,000/-
Causing death or abetting suicide	 10 Months	+	Rs. 50,000/-

1. Ragging is prohibited as per Act 26 of A.P. Legislative Assembly, 1997.
2. Ragging entails heavy fines and/or imprisonment.
3. Ragging invokes suspension and dismissal from the College.
4. Outsiders are prohibited from entering the College and Hostel without permission.
5. Girl students must be in their hostel rooms by 7.00 p.m.
6. All the students must carry their Identity Cards and show them when demanded
7. The Principal and the Wardens may visit the Hostels and inspect the rooms any time.
