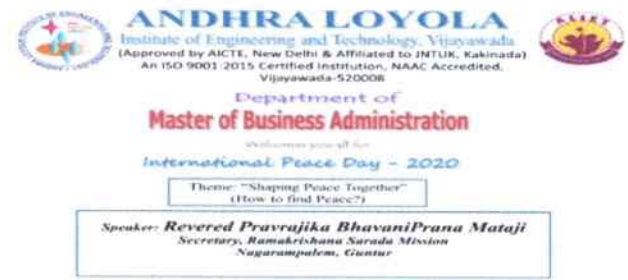
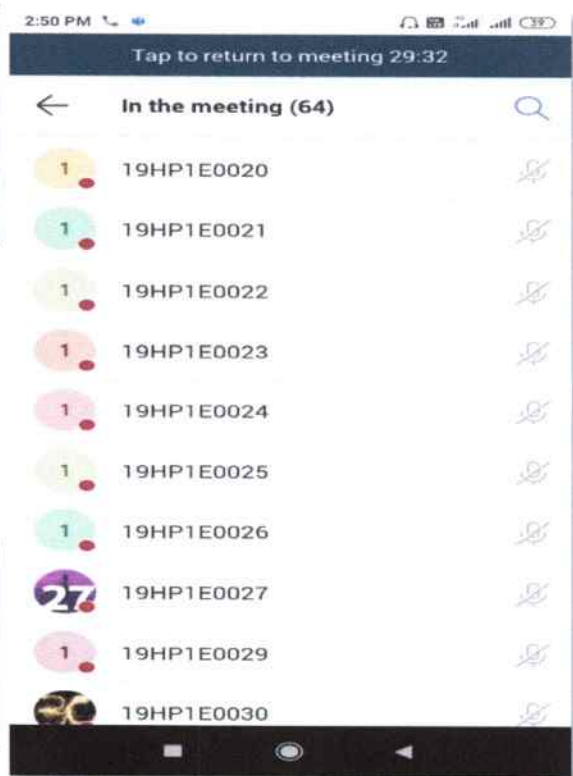
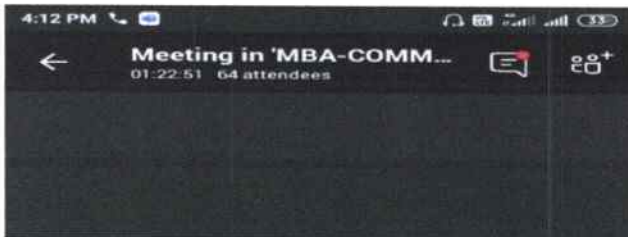
Event: International Peace Day

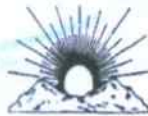

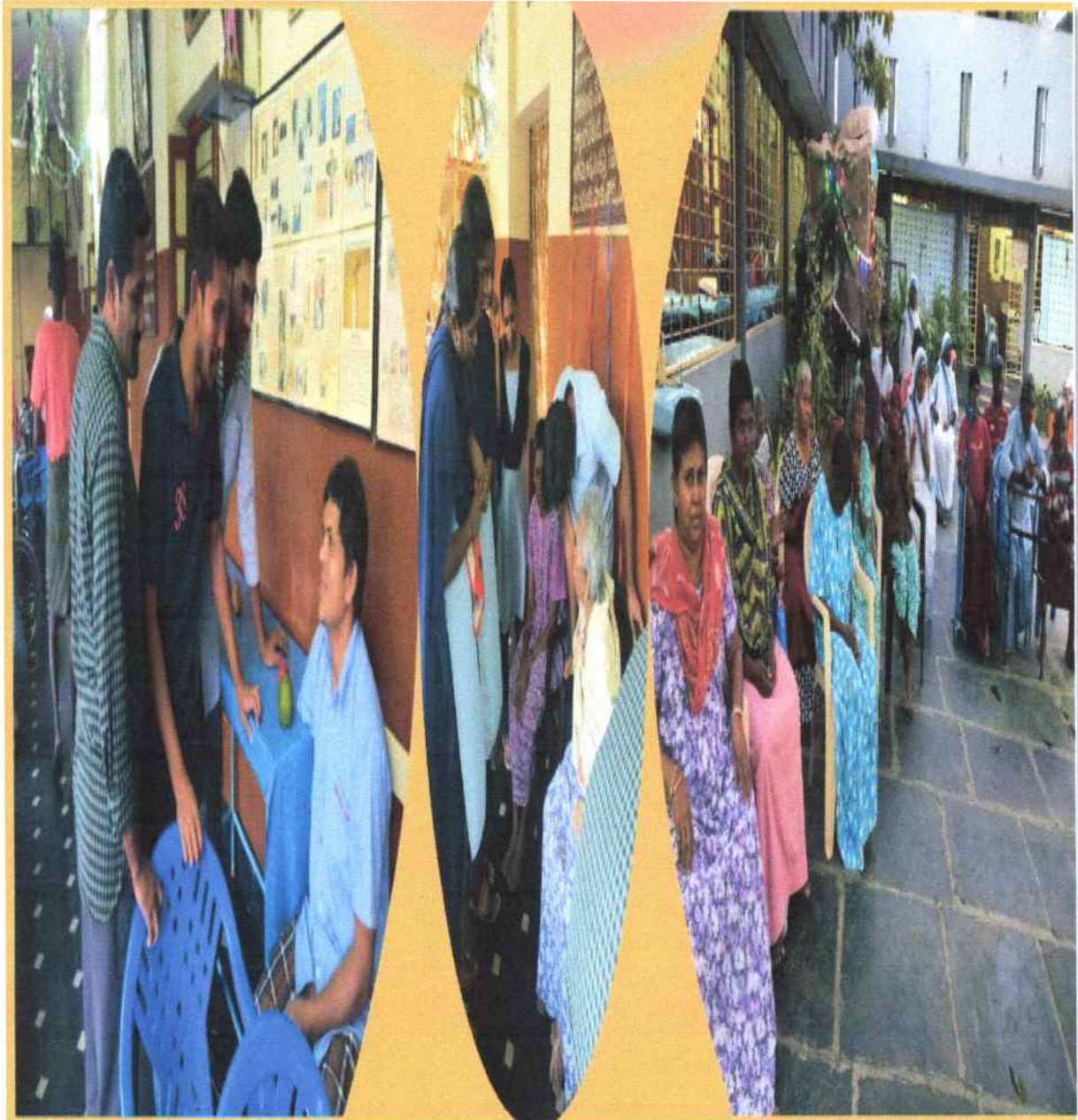
